August 25 - 28, 2011

## GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES

### READ THIS FIRST

1. Entries will be accepted on Thursday, August 25, 2011 from 9 a.m. to 12 noon at the Home Economics Show Exhibit area, including pre-registering for the Special Open Judging Contest to be held on Saturday, August 28th. See information on page 4.

Entries in this Show are limited to **RESIDENTS of KAUAI COUNTY**. There may be **TWO DIVISIONS: YOUTH** - 17 years and younger                      **ADULT** - 18 years and older

2. **ALL** entries must be made by the **EXHIBITOR** and exhibited for the **FIRST TIME** at the 2011 Kauai County Farm Bureau Fair Home Economics Show. The Committee reserves the right to refuse commercial and previously exhibited items and obviously worn or soiled entries.

3. An individual may NOT enter more than one (1) item in each GROUP. Additional items entered in a single **GROUP** will be put out for display only and not judged.

4. Entries for both **Youth and Adult Divisions MUST** be properly entered. Official **Display Tags** will be available at the Home Show exhibit area on Thursday August 25<sup>th</sup> or may be picked up in advance at the University of Hawaii Cooperative Extension Service Office, State Office Building, Room 210, Lihue (274-3471).

5. Judging will be by the Danish System. Therefore, there may be no ribbon awarded or there may be more than one blue, red, or white ribbon given for each **GROUP** within each **CLASS**. Decision of the judges is final. Ribbons and cash prizes will be awarded as follows:

**Youth & Adults:**            \*Best in Show: \$50      Blue: \$10      Red: \$7      White: \$5      HM: Ribbon

**\*Best in Show:** Up to NINE ribbons may be awarded, one in each of the following CLASSES:

**Adult Only** - QUILTS, NEEDLEWORK, ARTS & CRAFTS.

**Youth & Adults** - CHRISTMAS DÉCOR, RECYCLED ARTS & CRAFTS

**Youth Only** - LEGOS, QUILTED ITEMS, CLOTHING ACCESSORIES

**Special Ingredient Contest** - YAMS & SWEET POTATOES

**No Best in Show** in the Special Baking Contest - Open Judging

\*Best in Show winners will be posted in the Home Show Exhibit area.

6. All display items, ribbons and cash prizes **MUST BE PICKED UP BETWEEN 12-2 P.M. ON SUNDAY, AUGUST 28, 2011, in the Home Economics tent.** YOU MUST HAVE YOUR ENTRY RECEIPT to claim your prize. All unclaimed non-perishable items may be picked at the UH Extension Office (See address above.)

1. All entries must be a sewn or hand-crafted creation. **No store bought items will be accepted.**
2. There will be only one division.
3. These are two separate contests; **you may enter only one item in each.**
4. Judging will be by the Danish System (see page 1, item #5)

1. Create an ORIGINAL item using Legos, quilting techniques or fabric. No kits allowed.
2. These are three separate contests; you may enter one item in each.

## **SPECIAL INGREDIENT CONTEST - YOUTH & ADULTS**

### **CLASS IX: YAMS and/or SWEET POTATOES**

A Special Ingredient Contest using **Yams and/or Sweet Potatoes** in a Recipe will be held this year, 2011.

- GROUPS:**
1. BREADS (One loaf)
  2. MUFFINS (6 pieces)
  3. COOKIES (8 pieces)
  4. CAKES (One whole)

1. **Entries requiring refrigeration will not be accepted.**
2. Each entry in each GROUP must have the required number of pieces and be presented in a disposable covered container; i.e. a sealable plastic bag or plastic covered container. **Do not cover in plastic wrap or foil.** Enter no more than ONE item in each GROUP.
3. There will be only one Division (no distinction between Youth and Adult). All the rules of the Home Economic Exhibit apply (See page 1).
4. Judging will be by the Danish System and prizes will be awarded accordingly (See page 1, Item #5)
5. **RECIPE MUST** accompany the entries. All recipes become the property of KAFCE (Kauai Association for Family and Community Education), cannot be returned, and may be used by KAFCE in any and all media now known or hereafter developed for non-commercial and commercial purposes alike.

**ATTENTION:** To give you a chance to plan ahead, **Special Ingredients** have been selected for the following years:

**2012:** CITRUS (LEMONS, LIMES, ORANGES, GRAPEFRUIT, KUMQUAT, TANGERINES, ETC. OR IN COMBINATION)

**2013:** PINEAPPLE

**2014:** COCONUT

## **SPECIAL BAKING CONTEST - YOUTH & ADULTS**

### **CLASS X: OPEN JUDGING - KAUAI GROWN FRUIT PIE**

A new baking contest for 2011 will feature an **Open Judging to be held on Saturday, August 27, 2011, at 1 p.m.** Please bring your pie to the **Home Economic Show Exhibition area at 12:30 p.m.** The pie should be pre-registered on Thursday, August 25, 2011 from 9:00 a.m. to 12 noon. For questions about the Contests, please call Lenore Klass, after June 1, 2011, 742-9358.

The **Open Judging** takes place before an audience. Exhibitor must be present at time of judging and will be responsible for taking that entry home or it will be disposed of by KAFCE.

**Open Judging** is an entertaining way to learn how the judging process works as well as an opportunity for the exhibitor to learn new techniques in baking.

### **RULES FOR OPEN JUDGING KAUAI GROWN FRUIT PIE**

1. All the rules of the Home Economics Exhibit apply with two (2) exceptions: **A pie needing refrigeration will be accepted, and the Entry may be presented in your own pie dish, covered in an appropriate manner to protect your pie.**
2. A **PIE** needing refrigeration **must be transported in an ice cooler with cooling medium** and kept there until that individual pie is judged and ribbon is awarded. Please label cooler on the bottom with your name.
3. An entry consists of one (1) **KAUAI GROWN FRUIT PIE.**
4. **Ribbon and Prize Money will be given out on Sunday, August 28, 2011 between 12-2 p.m.**
5. **RECIPE MUST** accompany the entry. The recipe becomes the property of KAFCE (Kauai Association for Family and Community Education) and will not be returned. It may be used by KAFCE in any and all media now known or hereafter developed for non-commercial and commercial purposes alike.
6. There will be only one Division (no distinction between Youth and Adult). Judging will be by the Danish System and prizes will be awarded accordingly. **(See page 1, item #5.)**
